Preparation Course for Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot

Vis Moot Boot Camp 2016

The purpose of the Vis Moot Boot Camp is to help improve the quality of preparation of Georgian teams, and thereby increase educational value of the Moot, by providing to all Georgian teams a good grounding in the basic subject matters of the Moot, in the basic rules of legal analysis & writing, as well as by introducing them to the resources available worldwide (online) and in Georgia.

The Content of the Boot Camp will cover: (i) introduction to international commercial arbitration under the UNCITRAL Model Law and 1958 New York Convention; (ii) introduction to the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (the “**CISG**”) and elements of international Sales transaction (INCOTERMS 2010); (iii) the basic rules of legal analysis, research and legal writing; and (iv) insights on how Moot works and directions on what is expected of students in the competition.

Who can participate: Students, who have been selected by Georgian universities as members of the team of the respective University for Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot may participate in the Boot Camp. Only universities planning to enter a team for 24th annual Willem C. Vis Moot are eligible to nominate up to 4 students and one coach for participation in the Boot Camp.

Venue: [New Vision University](#) Campus, Tbilisi, Georgia. Participants must allocate two days for the Boot Camp. The organizers and sponsors will provide meals during the Boot Camp.

Instructors: The Boot Camp will be led by experienced practitioners of Georgia, members of AIG, most of them former alumnae of the Moot.

Dates: October 1-2, 2016.

Commitment: The Boot camp is a two-day intensive workshop, where students are expected to attend all sessions and actively participate in discussions, as well as to do some reading before and some assignments in the course of the Camp. Thus, the students are expected to block these two days out of their calendar for full devotion to the Boot Camp, *i.e.* preparation for what will be the most exciting and challenging experience in their student lives – Vis Moot!
